

PTA General Meeting
Minutes from August 17, 2007

The PTA meeting was called to order at 4:07 p.m.

The minutes from the last PTA General Meeting were approved.

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer reported a balance of \$13,014.57. The treasurer's report was approved.
